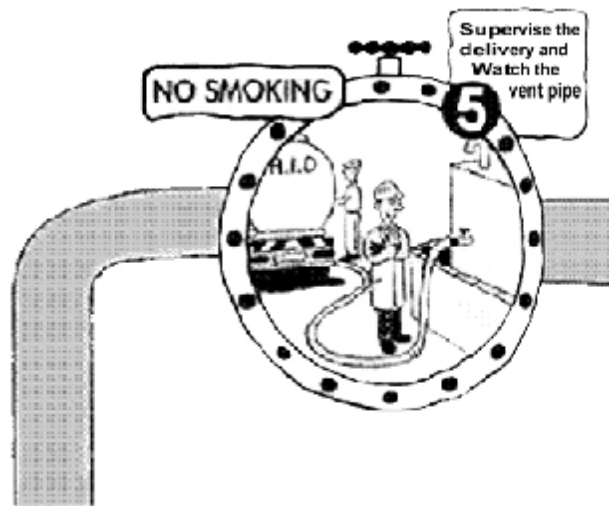
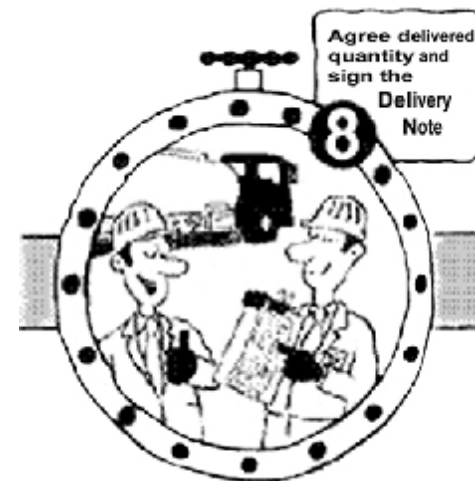
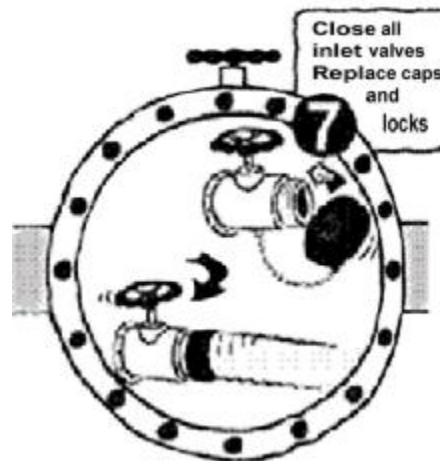
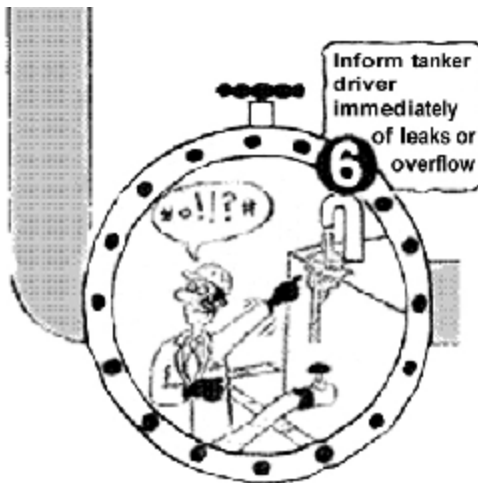


- It is important to know how much room is in the tank, a gauge is ideal.
- Check the paperwork for the correct product. Red Diesel put into a Derv tank is a costly error.
- If you can, label the fill point so a driver can be sure it's the correct one.
- The halfway point, make sure the inlet shut off valve is opened to receive.



- Have a responsible person to help with and supervise the delivery.
- Preventing a spillage is of the greatest importance so two heads are better than one.
- When the delivery is complete a responsible person can check that the valves are properly closed and that any locks are replaced.
- Finally check the paperwork again and sign for the delivery.
